PATROL DEPUTY REPORTS

Past Two Weeks Reported in Chronological Order

Tuesday, May 11

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all listed vacation watch checks. All homes appeared secure.

I responded to an email about homeless people sleeping in buildings in William Pond Park and forwarded it to Park Rangers.

I responded to a 911 hang-up on McClaren Drive, but it proved false.

I responded to a report that a vehicle was doing donuts in the William Pond parking lot and a parked car had a broken window. The suspect vehicle was gone when I arrived, but it later returned to the park. I responded to the scene again, stopped the vehicle and cited the driver for reckless driving. I also notified Park Rangers, who responded to complete their investigation of the broken window.

Wednesday Day, May 12

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all listed vacation watch checks. All homes appeared secure.

I responded to a report of an argument between two men at the shopping center at Fair Oaks Boulevard and Arden Way. The dispute was resolved.

Thursday Day, May 13
