# Aug. 25, 2021 Patrol Report

## **Tuesday-Wednesday 10 p.m.-4 a.m., Aug. 10-11**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed nearly all listed vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

While I was about to check on a home near the intersection of Marlborough and Jacob Lane, I noticed a green Dodge truck parked in front of the house. I conducted a DMV check and determined that the truck was stolen.

The female driver was nearby, so I detained her. Following an investigation, I arrested her and booked her into the Main Jail for possessing a stolen vehicle. It took me most of the rest of my shift to book all of her property and I had to find shelter for her six-week-old pit bull puppy. I also checked the home she had parked in front of to be sure there was no forced entry. It was secure. The truck was returned to its owner.

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all listed vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I assisted patrol by responding to an incomplete 911 call from the Rio Americano High School campus. We could not locate the person who made the call.

I responded to an audible alarm. It appeared to have been false.

I assisted patrol with a suspicious person near American River Drive and Watt Avenue. The subject checked clear and was asked to leave the area.

The rest of the shift was quiet.

## **Friday Day, Aug. 20**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all listed vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I watched stop signs throughout my shift to deter violations. I monitored dismissal traffic at Del Dayo Elementary and Rio Americano High School. Streets were congested at both locations, but I observed no major infractions.

## **Friday Night, 7 p.m.-3 a.m., Aug. 20-21**

Late at night, I came upon vehicle parked by a closed business on Fair Oaks Boulevard. I located the driver of the vehicle inside the courtyard of the business complex setting up a camp and had her leave the area.

I observed a woman sleeping on the sidewalk on Arden Way near Carmelo Drive. She had an outstanding felony warrant, so I arrested her and transported her to the Main Jail.

### **Monday, Aug. 23**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all listed vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I responded to a burglar alarm. It appeared to have been the result of a system malfunction.
