## PATROL DEPUTY REPORTS

### Past Two Weeks Reported in Chronological Order

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*Merry Christmas!*

#### **Thursday 8 a.m.-4 p.m., Dec. 11**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 12 scheduled vacation watch checks.

At one home, the front door had been left unlocked. I contacted the homeowner and was able to secure the home without any problems after checking to make sure nothing was disturbed. All other homes were secure.

I stopped and cited a driver who failed to stop at the stop sign at American River Drive and Kingsford Drive .

I stopped another driver who failed to stop at the stop sign at Estates Drive and Crondall Drive . The driver at first was apologetic and said she was just trying to get their child to school for a test. Once the driver realized I was writing a ticket, she became argumentative and insisted that she had stopped. She wanted my name and badge number and initially did not want to sign the ticket. I explained that the ticket was just a summons to promise to appear in court and that, if she did not sign it, I would have to place her under custodial arrest and take her to jail. The driver then signed with what I can only describe as a child throwing a tantrum by scribbling all over the ticket. I gave the driver a copy of the citation for the violation.

I stopped and cited another driver for not stopping at American River Drive and Jacob Lane.

I received an email about someone checking mailboxes on Gordon Lane on the morning of Dec. 11. The reporting party had ring doorbell footage from around 6:55 a.m. of an older white sedan with either dark or missing front hub caps. It was occupied by a driver and passenger. They were checking mailboxes, but did not remove anything from the boxes. #### **Friday, 5 p.m.- 12 a.m., Dec. 12**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 12 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I read the report of mailbox checking on Gordon Lane. I reviewed the video footage and tried using our license plate reader systems to see if I could develop any leads on a license plate, but had no luck.

#### **Sunday, 3-11 p.m., De. 14**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 19 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked all the river access points and Ashton Park, but saw no problems.

I monitored several intersections, but observed no traffic violations.

**Monday-Tuesday 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. , Dec. 15-16**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 21 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I stopped a 17-year-old driver for failing to stop at a stop sign on Gary Way. He apologized and I explained the possible consequences of his actions. I let him off with a warning, but first informed his father of the incident.

I checked on the river access points and Ashton Park multiple times. All were quiet. I monitored several intersections along American River Drive, but observed no traffic violations.

**Tuesday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Dec. 16**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 21 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure. One home had package delivered to the front door. I relocated it to the back yard and sent the owner a FYI email. Another on Meredith Way had a pickup parked in front and the side gate was open. I spoke with a man who was cleaning the pool and contacted the homeowner by phone. She confirmed that he was authorized to be there.

All river access points were clear.

I received an email from a resident on Gregory Way who found a piece of priority mail in their bushes. It had been addressed to a resident in the 5000 block of Shelly Way. The envelope had contained a passport, but it had been stolen. The victim filed a report with the postal service.

I monitored several intersections, but saw no traffic violations.

**Tuesday-Wednesday 8 p.m.-4 a.m., Dec. 16-17**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 19 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I patrolled the neighborhood, but everything was dead quiet. There were no issues at any park , river access point or roadway.

**Wednesday 10 a.m.- 4 p.m., Dec. 17**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 19 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked the river accesses and all three schools, but observed no problems.

I cited a driver on Chancery Way for a registration violation.

**Thursday 8 a.m.-4 p.m., Dec. 18**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 17 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I stopped and warned a driver for failing to stop at the sign at Crondall Drive and Chilham Way. I also issued warnings to two other drivers who failed to stop at the sign at Estates and Crondall.

**Friday, 10:30 p.m.- 4 a.m., Dec. 19-20**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 21 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

It rained and was a very quiet night.

**Saturday, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., Dec. 20**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 22 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I located an abandoned shopping cart on American River Drive filled with bags of recyclables. I checked all the properties in close proximity to the cart for signs of a potential camper, but did not find anyone.

There was a stalled vehicle in the middle of the road on Arden Way near McClaren Drive. I helped the driver to push it out of traffic and call for service.

It rained most of the shift and there was little pedestrian movement. Rio Americano was hosting a soccer event, but there were no traffic issues. I monitored the river access points and Ashton Park but observed nothing of concern.

**Saturday, 4-10 p.m., Dec. 20**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 22 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

At 9:30 p.m., I saw several teenagers walking in the rain near Ashton Park, then a couple more near Saverien Drive. I wasn't sure if they were looking for a party, but I stuck around to provide a visual presence, just in case.

It rained on and off throughout the night. All was quiet.

**Sunday, 6 a.m.- 2 p.m., Dec. 21**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 23 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked the river access points and Ashton Park multiple times. There was nothing of concern.

I responded to a burglar alarm in the 500 block of Rodante Way. The alarm involved a garage door activation. I arrived and found the door to be secure. I could hear the alarm activate while I was checking the home. I spoke with a neighbor, who said that the homeowner was out of town and he would let him know.

I monitored several intersections, but did not observe any traffic violations.

**Monday-Tuesday 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Dec. 22-23**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 29 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I responded to a report of loud music in the 4200 block on North River Way. I found no signs of a party, but I could hear music coming from inside the home. I knocked on the door multiple times, but there was no answer. A neighbor provided me with a phone number for the owner, so I left a voicemail asking them to turn down the music. Approximately five minutes later, the music was turned off.

I stopped and issued a verbal warning to a driver who failed to stop at the sign on Ashton Drive. The driver was a Middle Eastern man driving for Uber. I advised him of the possible consequences of his actions.

I checked the river access points and Ashton Park multiple times, but observed no problems. I also monitored several intersections on American River Drive, but saw no traffic violations.

**Tuesday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Dec. 23**

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 38 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked the river access points and Ashton Park multiple times, but observed no problems. I monitored a number of intersections on American River Drive, but saw no traffic violations.

I drove through the Rio Americano High School parking lot. I saw nothing suspicious.

### **IN AN EMERGENCY**

If you have an immediate emergency - if your life or property is in immediate danger, if you feel threatened by someone on or near your property, if you have just become the victim of a crime or if you are witnessing a crime in progress:

- CALL 911 from a land line.
- Or, if calling from a cell phone within Sacramento County, call (916) 874-5111.

### **TO REPORT A CRIME**

There are two ways to report a crime to the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department:

1. Call the Sheriff's Department NON-EMERGENCY LINE at (916) 874-5115. To bypass the recorded messaging when you call, dial 0 after the line is answered.
