



Twice-Monthly Patrol Report filed by WDDNA's Off-Duty Sheriff's Deputies

PATROL DEPUTY REPORTS

Past Two Weeks Reported in Chronological Order

Sunday, 3-11 p.m., May 11

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 29 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

It was a nice Mother's Day with lots of people out and about. All parks and river access points checked clear of any problems.

Monday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., May 12

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 30 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

There were two emails from members requesting follow-up information regarding recent door kick vandalisms. I emailed one member and met with the other at their home on Los Rios Drive.

I responded to a 911 call from a person on Los Rios Drive. The woman explained that the phone was acting up and that she and her husband couldn't figure out how to shut off the emergency call.

I checked on the parks and river access points, but observed no problems.

There was some rain in the morning which kept the foot traffic light.

Tuesday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., May 13

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 31 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked all the river access points and the schools. I observed no problems.

I responded to Arden Way and McClaren in response to a report of a woman walking in the roadway and lying down on someone's front lawn. She was clean and well dressed, but was non-verbal and shaking. Metro Fire responded and took her to Kaiser for medical evaluation.

I cited a vehicle parked in a No Parking zone at Whitehall and American River Drive.

I responded to a report of an assault at Rio Americano High School. The conflict was between two students and the parent of one of the students demanded an arrest. However, I watched a school video of the incident and determined that the student who said he had been assaulted was untruthful and had not been assaulted at all.

Tuesday-Wednesday 8 p.m.-4 a.m., May 13-14

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 27 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I performed a home security check for a WDDNA member on Jacob Lane. I spent about an hour going over suggestions for camera placement, window security and crime prevention through environmental design.

I stayed highly visible tonight by driving around with my forward flood lights on to deter any illegal activity.

Around 1:30 a.m., I noticed a white Nissan sedan on Guildford Court doing a u-turn. I made note of the vehicle's license plate number in case any criminal reports popped up later. It might have just been an Uber or newspaper delivery person.

Wednesday 8 a.m.-4 p.m., May 14

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 23 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked all the river access points and the schools, but saw no problems.

I responded to a request to do a welfare check in the 4500 block of Bailey Way. The house was secure and there was no way to access the interior.

I received an e-mail from a resident in the 900 block of Somersby Way who reported that a man in his 20s came to the front door wanting to know if they had a car for sale. It was very suspicious, so I checked the surrounding area several times, but did not locate the man.

Thursday 8 a.m.-4 p.m., May 15

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 27 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I drove past the schools and saw a vehicle illegally parked in a no-parking zone between Rio Americano High School and Whitehall. I cited the vehicle.

Sunday, 3-11 p.m., May 18

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 25 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I responded to a member near Meredith and Gregory Way who saw two men standing on his porch, but they never knocked on the door. A picture of an associated vehicle was provided and the registration showed the registered owner lives in Galt.

I checked on the river access points and the parks. All were clear of any problems.

I responded to Rio Americano High School following a report that two vehicles were locked in the parking lot. They were both gone when I arrived.

I monitored a couple intersections, but observed no traffic violations.

Tuesday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., May 20

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 30 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked the river access points, Ashton Park and monitored traffic at a number of locations. I observed no issues.

I responded to a report of a possible abandoned vehicle in the 1100 block of Los Rios. Although no description of the vehicle was provided, there was a white SUV that was legally parked and registered to an address outside of the county. It appeared to have been in the same spot past the 72-hour limit. I determined that the vehicle belongs to the father of a neighbor who has been hospitalized. The homeowner agreed to move the vehicle around to avoid a parking violation.

I responded to a disturbance call in the 1300 block of Meredith Way. There was a verbal confrontation between two men. Both checked clear of any wants or criminal history. I mediated the situation and both subjects went their separate ways.

A homeowner waved me down on McClaren Drive to thank us for monitoring traffic at Del Dayo Elementary School. He said the traffic speed is usually cut in half when we are in the area.

Tuesday-Wednesday 8 p.m.-4 a.m., May 20-21

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 27 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

All the parks and river access points were quiet.

I responded to an email from a member on Saverien Drive asking for help filing a report about a stolen pool sweep. The homeowner had video of the suspect and I asked that they email the video to me and to tell me how much the stolen item was worth so that I could file a report for them.

Thursday 8 a.m.-4 p.m., May 22

I patrolled the neighborhood and completed all 27 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I saw a young male driver run a stop sign at Crondall and Estates. When I stopped him, he said he was late for school at Rio Americano High School. I cited him for the violation.

I drove past the schools and saw a vehicle illegally stopped in the no-parking zone between Rio Americano High School and Whitehall. I advised the driver that there was no stopping there and he quickly left.

IN AN EMERGENCY

If you have an immediate emergency - if your life or property is in immediate danger, if you feel threatened by someone on or near your property, if you have just become the victim of a crime or if you are witnessing a crime in progress:

- CALL 911 from a land line.
- Or, if calling from a cell phone within Sacramento County, call (916) 874-5111.

TO REPORT A CRIME

There are two ways to report a crime to the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department:

1. Call the Sheriff's Department NON-EMERGENCY LINE at (916) 874-5115. To bypass the recorded messaging when you call, dial 0 after the line is answered.
