



Twice-Monthly Patrol Report filed by WDDNA's Off-Duty Sheriff's Deputies

PATROL DEPUTY REPORTS

Past Two Weeks Reported in Chronological Order

Saturday, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., May 24

I patrolled the streets and completed all 28 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I reviewed a resident's report of the theft of a pool sweep and am attempting to check other resources related to a vehicle that picked up the suspect after the theft.

There were no other issues to report today.

Saturday, 4-10 p.m., May 24

I patrolled the streets and completed all 26 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure. I notified one homeowner of a large package left on their front patio.

I followed up with the homeowner on Saverien Drive whose pool sweep was stolen. The homeowner filed a report online and provided a video of the suspect walking out to the street and getting picked up by a passing car. I followed up with the information she provided, but had no luck locating the suspect vehicle.

The traffic on American River Drive picked up substantially from 9 to 10:30 p.m. I monitored traffic at several locations, but observed no violations.

Sunday, 3-11 p.m., May 25

I patrolled the streets and completed all 28 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

There were two emails regarding parked vehicles that had been in place too long. One was in the 800 block of Robin Lane and the other in the 1700 block of Woodacre Court. I alerted parking enforcement officers about both cars.

I responded to a burglar alarm in the 1000 block of McClaren Drive. The alarm company said the front door had been opened. I arrived on scene within a few minutes and saw that the door was ajar. I checked the interior, but saw no signs of a break-in. I contacted a neighbor, who verified that the homeowners were gone. I secured the front door and went out the garage door.

I was dispatched to a vacant home in the 1600 block of Gary Way, where a neighbor had noticed that the front door was open. Upon my arrival, I found that the brother of the owner had arrived. He said that everything looked good, that his sister had probably forgotten to lock the door and that the wind had probably blown it open.

I checked the river access points and parks, but saw no problems or issues.

Monday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., May 26

I patrolled the streets and completed all 22 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked on the river access points multiple times today. It was very busy with people relaxing and fishing, but I observed no problems.

Parking enforcement officers checked on a couple of parked vehicles that had been reported by neighbors. One on Robin Lane was not on a county roadway, so officers had no authority to cite or tow it. The other vehicle on Woodacre Court was gone.

Tuesday 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., May 27

I patrolled the streets and completed all 23 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

A member sent an email about a lot that is being developed behind their home in the 4100 block of American River Drive. She was concerned about the noise coming from the property and that tennis courts are being added for which the developer wants to provide outdoor lighting. I referred her to county code enforcement and building permit offices.

I checked Ashton Park and all river access points, but saw nothing of concern.

I monitored several intersections but observed no traffic violations.

Tuesday-Wednesday 8 p.m.-4 a.m., May 27-28

I patrolled the streets and completed all 20 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

The streets and neighborhood were quiet. All parks and river access points checked clear.

Sounds of large fireworks going off could be heard all night. Dispatch reports suggest that the sounds were coming from outside the neighborhood.

Wednesday 8 a.m.-4 p.m., May 28

I patrolled the streets and completed all 25 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked river access points and the schools. There were no issues to report.

I cited a driver near San Ysidro and Fair Oaks Boulevard for having an expired vehicle registration. And I cited another vehicle on American River Drive at Whitehall for illegal parking.

Thursday 8 a.m.-4 p.m., May 29

I patrolled the streets and completed all 27 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I answered several emails regarding the recent door kicks and reported that the case is still open, but that the investigation may be near completion. When it is complete, the next step will be to send it to the District Attorney.

Patrol was dispatched to a possible burglary on Jacob Lane. Upon arrival, however, deputies determined that the wind likely had caused the homeowner to believe there was a burglary in progress.

Sunday, 3-11 p.m., June 1

I patrolled the streets and completed all 29 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked on the parks and river access points. All checked clear for any problems. Lots of people were hanging out at the Harrington river access.

I monitored a couple intersections on America River Drive, but observed no traffic violations.

Tuesday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 3

I patrolled the streets and completed all 26 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes

were secure.

There was a report that a tree branch on Saverien was obscuring signage warning drivers of the crosswalk at Fair Oaks Boulevard. I contacted the County Department of Transportation and asked that a crew be dispatched to fix the issue.

I monitored traffic at Offham Court and Ashton Drive. I stopped and gave a verbal warning to a driver for failing to come to a complete stop at the intersection.

I monitored traffic at the 4-way stop at Ashton and Saverien. I gave a verbal warning to another driver for failing to come to a complete stop at the intersection.

I checked all the river access points several times, but observed no issues. Ashton Park also checked clear.

Tuesday-Wednesday 8 p.m.-4 a.m., June 3-4

I patrolled the streets and completed all 24 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

Around 9:30 p.m. I saw two older teens riding electric bikes inside the Rio Americano High School parking lot. They scurried away when I shined my lights on them. I noticed that they tried going back about 30 minutes later, so I made them leave again by warning them using my public address speaker.

Around 10 p.m. I responded to a report of a report of transients sleeping in a car in the vicinity of Estates and Crondall Drive. I spoke with the man and woman, who said they were trying to remove a metal pull cart from their trunk to give to a friend. They did not have any active warrants.

Around 1 a.m. a woman was heard screaming for help near River Oak Way and the Sarah Court river access. When I arrived to help the patrol unit that responded, we determined that the 48-year-old woman was actually on the south side of the river and was screaming for help because her phone was dead and she had gotten lost and had been trying to find her way home for a few hours. We were able to guide a Rancho Cordova patrol deputy to her location and take her home.

Wednesday 10 a.m.- 2 p.m., June 4

I patrolled the streets and completed all 25 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I checked all the river access points and the schools. All were clear.

Saturday, 4-10 p.m., June 7

I patrolled the streets and completed all 21 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

While patrolling, I noticed a lot of graduation and birthday parties occurring, so I checked the parks and river access points multiple times just to be sure that the parties did not migrate and cause a problem. They all checked clear of any problems or teens partying after hours.

Sunday, 6 a.m.- 2 p.m., June 8

I patrolled the streets and completed all 21 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

All parks and river access points checked clear of any problems. I monitored several intersections, but did not observe any traffic violations.

I received an email reporting that a driveway was blocked by a parked vehicle in the 4900 block of Keane Drive. Fortunately, it was moved before I arrived.

Monday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 9

I patrolled the streets and completed all 18 scheduled vacation watch checks. All homes were secure.

I responded to a panic alarm in the 4900 block of Keane Drive. I arrived within a minute and contacted the homeowner, who said it was accidental.

I monitored several intersections throughout my shift, but I did not see any traffic violations.

IN AN EMERGENCY

- Or, if calling from a cell phone within Sacramento County, call (916) 874-5111.

TO REPORT A CRIME

There are two ways to report a crime to the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department:

1. Call the Sheriff's Department NON-EMERGENCY LINE at (916) 874-5115. To bypass the recorded messaging when you call, dial 0 after the line is answered.
